Temporary Waiver of Vehicle Title & Registration Requirements Ends 04.14.21

If you're overdue, it's time to renew! The temporary waiver of certain vehicle title and registration requirements, announced by Governor Greg Abbott on March 16, 2020, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, will end on April 14, 2021.

If you have not renewed your expired vehicle registration, you should make plans to renew by that date. It is not necessary to wait until the deadline to complete any overdue transactions as motorists have several renewal options.

Calling in Sick

- If you are calling in for any kind of illness, you **MUST** call the Nursing Hotline **FIRST**. If you or anyone in your household is tested for COVID-19 you must call the Nursing Hotline immediately. You can reach this line by dialing **INFO (x4636)** from any campus phone or by calling **692-4053 x4636** from off-campus.
- **Please watch for calls from the Hotline after you leave a message! The call will come from a "795-3xxx" number** or a Cell Phone number you likely don't know. Nursing **will** return your call but many times they do not get an answer and/or your voicemail is not setup.
- **You must report being tested for COVID-19 (and then report your results if applicable) immediately to the Nursing hotline. Failure to do so will result in disciplinary action.**

Ready for Tax Time?

Tax Time is almost here – taking action **now** will save you time and let you file faster!

You can receive your W-2 and 1095-C forms electronically (when then are released by HHSC) instead of waiting on them to come via regular mail. This can save you 7-10 days or more!

You must consent (or have done so previously) in order to get your forms electronically – otherwise they will mailed to your address in CAPPS.

Please take a few minutes to check/update your W2/1095-C status in CAPPS. You will be glad you elected to receive these electronically when the W-2s are available!
