Social Security Scams

Social Security Scams have become very common – many times you will receive a call that makes it sound like it's an official with Social Security when it reality it's not. Below are some tips to keep you safe:

IF YOU RECEIVE A SUSPICIOUS CALL:

1. Hang up!
2. DO NOT give them money or personal information!
3. Report the scam at OIG.SSA.GOV!

Social Security may call you in some situations but will never:

- Threaten you
- Suspend your Social Security Number
- Demand immediate payment from you
- Require payment by cash, gift card, pre-paid debit card, or wire transfer
- Ask for gift card numbers over the phone or to wire or mail cash

What to look out for

- The call or email says there is a problem with your Social Security Number or account.
- Someone asking you to pay a fine or debt with retail gift cards, wire transfers, pre-paid debit cards, internet currency, or by mailing cash.
- Scammers pretend they're from Social Security or another government agency. Caller ID or documents sent by email may look official but they are not.
- Callers threaten you with arrest or other legal action.

Life Safety Code Tip of the Week

No storage of significant or concentrated quantities of combustibles/flammables except in areas designed and equipped for that purpose. Chemical storage (of any kind) should be very limited at the home/department.
