Campus Road Construction

Beginning July 6th, a TxDOT contractor will be doing work on Smokestack Drive, located between Food Service & Laundry. This area stretches east/west between Service Avenue & Plum. The contract is for 30 days in length but they are hoping to be done no later than July 22nd.

This will mainly affect parking for Food Service, Laundry & Infirmary staff but there will also be occasional road closures on both Service Avenue & Plum. Please be watching for cones/barriers and plan for alternate routes. **Do not** try to move a cone or barrier and go through the construction area.

The contractor may also use the parking lot just south of the Chapel for material and equipment so this will affect parking in that area as well.
