Transporting Individuals in Wheelchairs



Remember that Individuals that utilize wheelchairs cannot be loaded facing backwards while being transported. Policy and curriculum both state that a **person who utilizes a wheelchair must be facing forward** while being transported unless otherwise approved.

Some reasons for this procedure:

If the van is in an accident or must stop suddenly, the person being transported will have their head move forward which is more natural than having their head snap backwards because they are facing the rear of the vehicle.

It is just a courtesy for the passenger who utilizes a wheelchair to be facing the same direction as the driver and other passengers.

This is a critical part of keeping everyone safe!
