When do I call 4444?

- Call **4444** when an emergency medical situation occurs with a person who lives at AbSSLC or after you have called **911** for a an employee, volunteer or visitor.

Have as much information available as possible concerning the situation including **Location of Emergency, Name of Person, Age of Person, Type of Emergency**

Example:

This is Ima Staff at Home/Building/Department. I have a 32 year old male named John Doe with severe bleeding from a head injury. He is alert right now.

- Call **4444** when help is needed for a Behavior Crisis. You will need to tell the Operator who is involved, where the Behavior Crisis is occurring and any details you can.

When Do I Call 911?

- Call **911** when an emergency medical situation occurs with an employee, volunteer or visitor. Don't forget to call **4444** to let them know you have called **911**.
- Call **911** if CPR has been started on anyone (Individual or Employee/Volunteer/Visitor)

Have as much information available if possible concerning the situation:

Location of Emergency, Name of Person, Age of Person, Type of Emergency, Health conditions if you know of any, **Medications** the person taking if you know or can ask, **Type of accident**

Example:

This is Ima Staff at AbSSLC at Home/Building/Department. I have a 26 year old female named Jane Doe experiencing chest pains, she is sweating profusely, clammy to the touch and pale with labored breathing. She has a history of heart problems and is currently taking XYZ medication.

Remember to call 4444 if you have not already done so and stay on the line until they instruct you to hang up. If you are the only person that is responding let them know so they will get off the phone as soon as they can.
