

### New Campus Entrance!

Effective @ 6am on Thursday, October 6<sup>th</sup>, we will change the 24/7 Campus Entrance to Maple & 1<sup>st</sup> Street.



It's important to note the following as we make this change:

- Once the new gate opens, both the Lakeside/21<sup>st</sup> & Centennial Park gates will not be available. The only 24/7 entrance & exit will be @ Maple/1<sup>st</sup> Street.
   We will continue to open Maple/3<sup>rd</sup> Street @ 12pm & 5pm (Monday-Friday only) for 30 minutes to allow traffic to exit.
- The Centennial Park gate will **not be available** after Tuesday, 10/5. Maintenance will be moving the small building from there to the new entrance.
- The current process of showing your badge (with mask on!) at the gate will
  continue. This helps ensure the safety for those living & working at AbSSLC.
   Please slow to 5mph when approaching the entrance/exit booth and, remember
  to dim your lights when it's dark.

Please be patient with the change. Acting ugly, acting like you are too important to be bothered by the process and/or telling the person at the gate how stupid this is doesn't help — and will simply slow you down. And yes, amazingly enough, this does happen ...
