## **Food Delivery to Campus**

To assist with on-going issues, all food service delivery drivers (GrubHub, Doordash, etc.) will be required to deliver to the gate – they cannot come directly to the home/building where you work. Family members & friends (with a designated driver card) can still come directly to you.

We still have staff speeding through the entry/exit without regard to the safety of the staff working there. This is recorded on video and your supervisor will be notified when this occurs. Continued issues could result in your losing your privilege to drive on campus.
