When do I call a Behavior Crisis?

A Behavior Crisis can be called by dialing **4444** from any campus phone anytime you feel that an Individual's behavior is placing themselves or others at immediate risk of harm and you need extra staff support/guidance. A crisis can be called as a **Code 1** or **Code 2**, depending on your view of the severity of the situation. For example, a Code 1 might be when someone is outside in the extreme cold and refusing to come in, while a Code 2 might be warranted when someone is throwing rocks at staff or Individuals.

A **Code 3** is the most severe code and is <u>only</u> called by BHS Staff.

Status of HVAC Work

This project (unlike the Cottage project we talked about last week) is doing great and is actually **ahead** of schedule. When done, we will have 8 homes off of the Central Plant (Powerhouse) steam!

AbSSLC Entry/Exit Gate

As of Monday, March 13th @ 5am the 1st/Maple Street Gate will serve as our Main Entrance/Exit.

From **0700-0830** (**M-F**), this gate will be **entry only** for the campus. During this time, the 24th/Maple gate will be **exit only**. All other times, the 1st/Maple gate will serve as entry/exit.

The red/green lights on 1st Street & 24th Street will help indicate what gates are available for exit.

Selecting your Lane

You can use either lane to enter campus but each lane will exit a different direction:

- The North (left) lane will go straight on 1st Street.
- The South (right) lane will immediately turn right and go through the Nursing/LSCTH parking lot to 3rd Street.

This is being done to help reduce traffic congestion after you have been cleared to enter. You will likely want to select your lane based on where you work.

Checks of pick-up truck beds will continue. Please ensure your truck bed is empty of any objects that could be considered dangerous to those that live here. If items are found, you will need to secure them in the cab or take the vehicle back off campus.

Please be patient as we learn our new traffic pattern!
