Email Phishing

Email is a common vector for malware and ransomware. Please remain vigilant of phishing attempts that will take advantage of the harried season of IRS tax filing.

Be aware of email messages claiming to be from familiar organizations or individuals asking you to reveal personal or HHS information, such as passwords or credit card numbers. These emails may actually be malware threats.

If you suspect a phishing attempt, always use the Phish Alert button in Outlook.

Typical Red Flags

- Unfamiliar tone or greeting given the context of the sender and message
- Inconsistencies in email addresses, hyperlinks, web addresses, and display names
- Threats or requirements to respond with a sense of urgency
- Unusual requests to not follow a policy or to send money in an unconventional manner
- Suspicious attachments, file types, or the names of file (e.g., @pps\$5B2A3D1E076.rar)
- Requests for credentials, payment information, or other personal details

Never Take These Actions:

- Reply to the message
- Attempt to visit hyperlinks within the message
- Save or open attachments
- Simply delete the message or move it to "junk" folder
