Attending a prescreen prior to treatment day will get your paperwork, exam, and X-Rays out of the way and shorten your wait on treatment day. No treatment is done at prescreen. It is NOT required to attend treatment day but is highly recommended.

- What you need to know for prescreen:
- must be 8+ to get treatment
  - Patients under 18 but have a parent or guardian present
  - know your medical history and bring a list of current medications

Ear pods (and headphones) cannot be used unless your supervisor has given you explicit permission to do so. These create a safety risk because you cannot hear things around you.

### Vehicle Safety

With Summer upon us, remember that you should only leave your windows down **1" or less** for ventilation. This is very important to the safety of those that live here so they can't get into your vehicle. Adding a sunshade to your window(s) can also help with the heat!
