

#### Smiles going to/from this Special AbSSLC Clinic!

Dental Hygienist Pam Acevedo, with the support of Dentists Dr. Jerry Griffin and Dr. Mark Bullock, created a specialized clinic for our campus, focusing on Dental Desensitization. It is a unique behavior management program unlike any other within the SSLC system.





Dr. Griffin and Pam started the clinic in response to Individuals having difficulty in a Dental clinic setting. Their goal was to reduce the use of sedation, reduce the need for restrictive practices in managing behavior during dental services and improve the oral health for those we serve. Implementing principles and working closely with other professionals from both Behavioral Services and Habilitation Services, the program has created a winning combination of behavior, sensory and dental care that is carefully tailored to the unique needs of each person. Dr. Bullock states the program's long-term goal is to "teach individuals to be good dental patients in any dental setting."



But how do they accomplish this? Careful research of the person's needs and motivations, along with a good measure of care and kindness. One person might be enjoying their favorite country song while learning to tolerate soft brushing while another is treated to a light show that helps them to relax. Pam uses a wide range of sensory ideas that make anxious patients begin to trust and enjoy the experience. It may not seem obvious that a person relaxes, laughs and leaves the Dentist smiling and wanting a return visit ... but that is the magic behind a dedicated team that makes a difference above and beyond.
