Food Service Director Shelia Nance recently reached an honored milestone - 25 years in Food Service at AbSSLC! Shelia started as a Food Service Worker and impressed people along the way as a Cook, Cook II, Food Service Manager and for the past several years, as our Director of Food Service.

As any chef will tell you, the end product of any recipe is the result of dedicated behind-the-scenes work. The Food Service team of over 90 dedicated staff is no exception. Shelia and her team oversee the advance ordering, delivery, and stocking of shipments of fresh fruit and veggies, dry goods, dairy and breads. They also clean on a massive scale with rows of ovens, extra-large pots, blenders, grinders, slicers, choppers all of which are kept in spotless condition. Additionally, racks of food trays are delivered to our homes by a fleet of trucks and drivers. It's an impressive operation from an early start to a late finish each day.

The results speak for themselves. Shelia and her team provide an average of 12000+ meals per month. This includes dozens of special dietary menus and careful attention to required food textures. Add in scheduled events such as the Family Day Picnic and dances at the Gym and you have one busy team!

When asked what motivates her each day, Shelia turned the focus to others. "It's the people who live and the people who work here" and added "the individuals are counting on us every day, and we are in a way, their employees."
