State Vehicles

The Attorney General's Office has clarified the definition of a



"State Vehicle" – and the requirements to be able to drive one. A State Vehicle is now considered to be **any type** of vehicle owned by the State. This includes, of course, cars/vans & trucks but **also** includes golf carts & utility vehicles.

In order to be able to drive a State Vehicle as defined above, you must have a **current** Texas Drivers License and be **current** in your Defensive Driving training. In addition, you must be cleared through the Driving Program maintained by FCT/D and be on the list of valid drivers.

This is a big change for all – in the past a golf cart was not considered a vehicle and didn't fall under some of the same rules as a car/van/truck would. This has now changed and you **must** be a valid State Driver to drive <u>any type</u> of State vehicle on campus.

FCT/D will be issuing cards that will be attached with your AbSSLC Badge to show what



vehicles you are cleared to drive. Security will, in turn, be checking to ensure drivers are following the required policy.


