New Off-Campus Trip Procedures

As you have likely heard, new procedures for **off-campus** trips start on January 1st. This process involves extensive planning for the trip as well as multiple layers of approval.

As part of the process, the gate staff will need to complete a detailed inspection of the vehicle when it is leaving campus – this will include checking passengers, the condition of the vehicle, required items in the vehicle (such as a first aid kit and Ukeru pads), etc. As you might guess, this process will take some time.

When a state vehicle is leaving campus, the Gate Staff will place a cone across the incoming lane to hold traffic while they perform their inspection and complete the needed paperwork. This will, in turn, cause short(ish) delays – you should be prepared for this delay and not try to go around the cones. Failing to follow the proper procedures could result in you losing your privilege to drive on campus.

It's important to note that all of the items checked on the vehicle leaving must match the form (staff going, Individuals going, proper equipment) and all of the signatures must be present – unless everything is correct the driver will be instructed not to leave campus and to return to the home. The state vehicle should move as close to the shed as possible for Gate Staff to perform their check.
