AbSSLC Construction Update

Cottages

Cottages 6750 and 6750 are getting close to completion. Our hope is to have them completed by mid-February and get started on the last two (6690 and 6700). It also looks like we will be able to replace the very old sprinkler systems in each cottage as part of this renovation.

HVAC at the North/South Quads

This project is done with all 8 buildings now having heating that is independent of the Power House.

Laundry Boiler

This project is done – the laundry steam system is now independent of the Power House.

HVAC at various buildings

Work continues to replace the outside chiller units at several buildings with several more coming in the next 3-4 months. In addition, 3 buildings (648, 650, 651) will have their inside air-handlers replaced as well.

Campus Fencing

The campus fence project is moving along quickly and is ahead of schedule. 10 feet of chain link has been completed on the North/East/South sides with the final 2 feet of "no climb" fencing will be added in the next couple of weeks. The ornamental fence on Maple is about 35% done.
